The Humane Society of Manatee County is committed to leading Manatee County in fostering compassion and respect for all animals through care, education and collaboration. The philosophy of the Humane Society of Manatee County is that treatment of animals is a reflection of our community. We are proud of our high quality, high volume spay / neuter program, TNR (trap / neuter / return program), Second Chance Shelter Adoptions, pet retention efforts and the high quality medical care provided for the animals of Manatee County at our veterinary clinic.

The Humane Society of Manatee County actively collaborates with other animal welfare organizations within the community to reduce euthanasia of animals as a means of population control. This collaborative effort extends to those in the community that may be financially challenged, making sure that all animals in Manatee County receive the medical care, vaccines and care they deserve. Our community outreach efforts and collaboration continue to expand as well.

The Humane Society of Manatee County Pet Health Center / Veterinary Clinic continues to increase the services offered to the animals of our community. Low cost spay / neuter is available to the public by appointment, as well as pet wellness exams for dogs and cats. Vaccines, microchipping and both dog and cat dental services are also available to the public. Those who are clients of our Pet Health Center / Veterinary Clinic can also buy their pet medications online(www.humanemanatee.org) and at our veterinary clinic located at 2415 14th Street West in Bradenton.

Our shelter's Second Chance Adoption Program adopts out more than 100+

animals each and every month, saving lives four paws at a time. We believe that keeping pets in loving homes is as important as finding new homes for homeless animals. The Pet Safety Net program includes a pet food pantry, behavioral issue training and trained adoption counselors who are here to help. In addition to making donations to support our shelter program there are many volunteer opportunities available. Volunteers play a key role in our organization's success.
